We Are So Thankful For You!

There is a lot to be thankful for this Thanksgiving season! Thanks to your generous support, our programs are reaching more students than ever! The Summer Internship Program grew from 99 interns and 75 businesses in 2021 to 142 interns and 96 businesses in 2022. Another 100 students have participated in our Work Study program. Since the beginning of these programs, over 600 college and high school students have experienced local careers. Additionally, Young AmeriTowne of Kansas has welcomed 1,658 fourth through eighth grade students from 27 public, private, and home-school groups, with an average of 700 students per school year. This spring, the numbers will top 2,000 as we host another 645 students from the area to this financial literacy/career program. Finally, YOU have helped pave the way for a new, high school program, Life\$kills. Curriculum development is underway, and we plan to launch soon! Juniors and seniors will learn budgeting, community involvement, interviewing skills, resume writing, how to be wise consumers, and other life skills in preparation for adulting.
